LOCATION OF DATA PROCESSING

The processing relative to web services offered by this site is carried out at the operating headquarters of the data controller Company and are only handled by the employees, collaborators, or associates of **FLECTA** who are in charge of the data processing, or if it is necessary to associates, employees, and collaborators of affiliates and subsidiaries of **FLECTA**, by any eventual persons in charge of maintenance under the strict supervision of the data controller.

No data resulting from the use of web services shall be communicated or disclosed to third parties.

The personal data provided by the users who access the service is only used for the service itself or to provide requests and are communicated to third parties only if it is necessary for that purpose.

Connection data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website collect, during their regular operation, certain personal data, transmission of which is implicit in the communication protocols of the Internet.

This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but, because of its nature, could allow to identify users, through processing and association with data held by third parties.

This category of data includes IP addresses or computers' domain names used to access the site, the addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of server's response (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters regarding the operating system and user's computing environment.

This data is only used to obtain anonymous statistical information on site usage and to check its correct functioning and is deleted immediately after processing.

The data in question could be used to assess liability in case of any cybercrime against our site.

It may also be communicated, upon the request of public authorities and State administrative bodies, for purposes related to fulfilment of law obligations, for reasons of investigation, detection, and repression of administrative, accounting, fiscal, tax, and criminal offences.

COOKIES

We do not use cookies to transfer personal information, nor the so-called persistent cookies of any kind, or any systems to track users.

The use of session cookies (which are stored in a persistent way on the user's computer and disappear after the browser is closed) is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to allow a safe and efficient visit of the site.

The session cookies used on this site avoid the use of other methods that are potentially detrimental to the confidentiality of the user's browsing and do not allow the collection of identifying personal information.

THE VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA SUPPLY

PROCESSING METHOD

Personal data is processed with automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected. Specific and appropriate security measures and organisational procedures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use, and unauthorised access.

THE RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

The individuals whom the personal data refers to have the right to obtain at any time the confirmation whether such data exists, to know its content and origin, to verify its accuracy, to request an update, integration, or correction pursuant to the current legislation.

Pursuant to the current legislation, the interested party/the user has the right to request the cancellation, the anonymisation, or the block of the data processed in violation of the law, as well as to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, to the processing.
